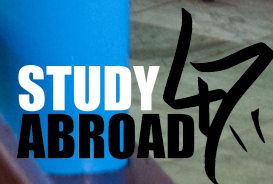

Our host universities are located in urban locations, close to public transportation, and in purpose-built facilities that provide a pleasant study atmosphere to match our diverse choice of innovative programs.

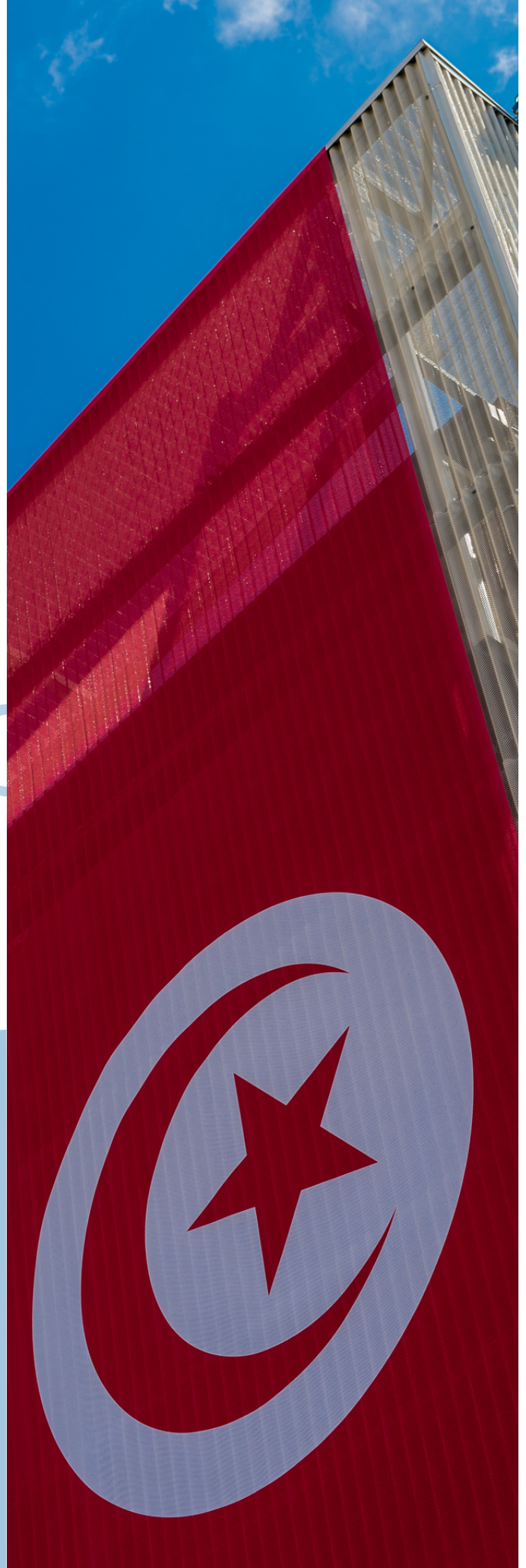

02 Visa

You will need a valid Visa to enter. Please do not wait until the last minute to obtain your Visa. Some countries allow border-entry VISAS upon arrival. PassportHealthUsa.com is a VISA provider

03 Vaccinations & COVID-19

The Yellow Fever vaccination is the only REQUIRED vaccination to enter, Malaria pills are suggested . COVID-19 negative test results required 72 hours before departure & upon entering Ghana.

04 Travel & Medical Insurance

Courses

01 Beginners Arabic

Beginning Arabic has an interdisciplinary and experiential focus. The main objectives of the course are to develop emergent proficiency in spoken Arabic, strengthen listening, comprehension, and communication skills; use the language confidently and effectively in everyday situations; acquire insight into the role of Arabic within Tunisian life and culture.

03 Food Culture & Migration in the Mediterranean

Food has always been crucial to people's life experiences, especially migrants who take with them their cultures, traditions and lifestyles.. In this course, we will taste foods from other cultures and listen to stories of migrants in the Euro-Mediterranean region and understand the challenges they face in their new homes.

02 Gender and Sexuality Studies

This course introduces major concepts in the interdisciplinary field of gender and sexuality studies. We will analyze the ways in which gender, as a subject of study and as a lived experience, intersects with class, race, and ability and will examine the relation between gender & sexuality in cultural, social, political, artistic, and medical discourses in a Muslim country.
